Attendance Matters

THE GRANGE SCHOOL

We strongly believe in tackling attendance early before it causes longer term problems for your child and there are many reasons why we address this from the very start of the year.

Pupils who missed 2 to 4 days in September were 5 times more likely than those who missed fewer than 2 days to be chronically absent for the year. Half the pupils who miss 2-4 days in September go on to miss nearly a month of school.

This is a significant amount of time! We firstly aim to support. Please share with us any difficulties you may have in regards to your child's attendance - we want to help! If attendance is causing a concern you will be invited in for a meeting to discuss the reasons behind it and offered support.

Promoting positive attendance is everyone's responsibility and we appreciate your support with this. If you have any concerns or difficulties with your child's attendance, please contact Mrs Best as soon as possible so that we can support and offer help where possible.

My name is Danielle Spencer and I am a learning support assistant here at The Grange school. This is my second year supporting the learning in the year one area and my passion in the classroom is ensuring that all learning is accessible for all children.

Outside of the classroom I love to share my positivity- you will often hear my good morning before you see me! My favourite poem (which I am very often heard singing) is one we focused on in year one last year called 'smiling is infectious' by Spike Milligan and I love to share my smile! I am committed to understanding each child I meet and making sure every child has a voice. To ensure I can do this effectively I commit myself to extra training inside and outside of school- currently I am learning sign language with BSL, which has proven a real beneficial and fun language to learn.



All of our school staff have been busy developing and updating their skills. This week we have been focusing on 'de-escalation strategies'. These strategies are particularly useful when I child is feeling overwhelmed and are struggling to regulate their emotions.







Each week in assembly, we learn about our values through a Changemaker.

Last week's value was Integrity. We learnt about how Michelle Obama demonstrated integrity when faced with challenges by staying true to her values and living by her motto "When they go low, we go high". Telling the truth and doing the right thing are extremely important to her.





We also explored Michelle Obama as a pioneering black woman as part of Black History Month. We learnt that she was the first African-American First Lady of the United States. She has become a role model for women and an advocate for healthy families, service members and their families, higher education, and international adolescent girls education.
