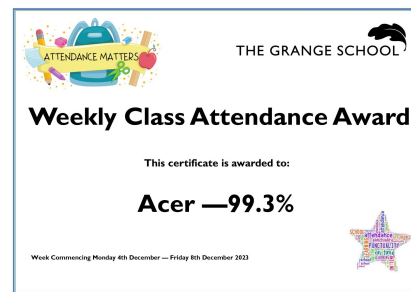

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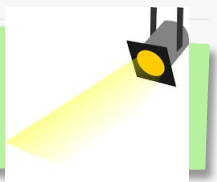

Outside of school I love to spend time with my daughter and family.



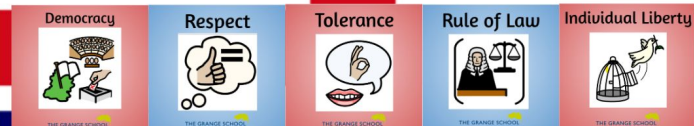
