IMPORTANT INFORMATION: - reception to Y4 only

Please inform 0-19 team immediately if any of the following occurs:

- If your child is unwell or has been off school in the 48 hours prior to vaccination.
- If your child has a temperature the day before or on the day of vaccination.
- If your child is has been wheezy in the 48 hours prior to the vaccination session or they have had their asthma medication increased.
- **b** If your child has taken or been commenced on oral steroids in the 2 weeks prior the vaccination sessions.
- **b** If your child has been given the vaccination elsewhere.
