Ways in which you can help with attendance:

Our whole school attendance since the start of the academic year is 93.9% which is below our expected target of 96%. Below are some ways that you could help your child with attendance.

Make attendance a priority - **Miss school, miss out!**Set out a clear routine with your child, prepare for school the night before to avoid being late in the morning.
If you have any difficulties getting your child to school, then please call us to discuss this.

Any medical appointments must be supported with evidence in order for these to be authorised – please bring these in to the front office. Where possible, appointments should be made outside of school hours.

Please remember that we are able to administer Calpol (with parental consent) and often this is enough to keep a child feeling well enough to be in school. If we are ever concerned about a child, we will always ring home. It is also worth bearing in mind that if you have made the decision early morning to keep your child at home and by mid-morning they've made a miraculous recovery then please do bring them in – we would prefer a child comes in late than not at all!
