

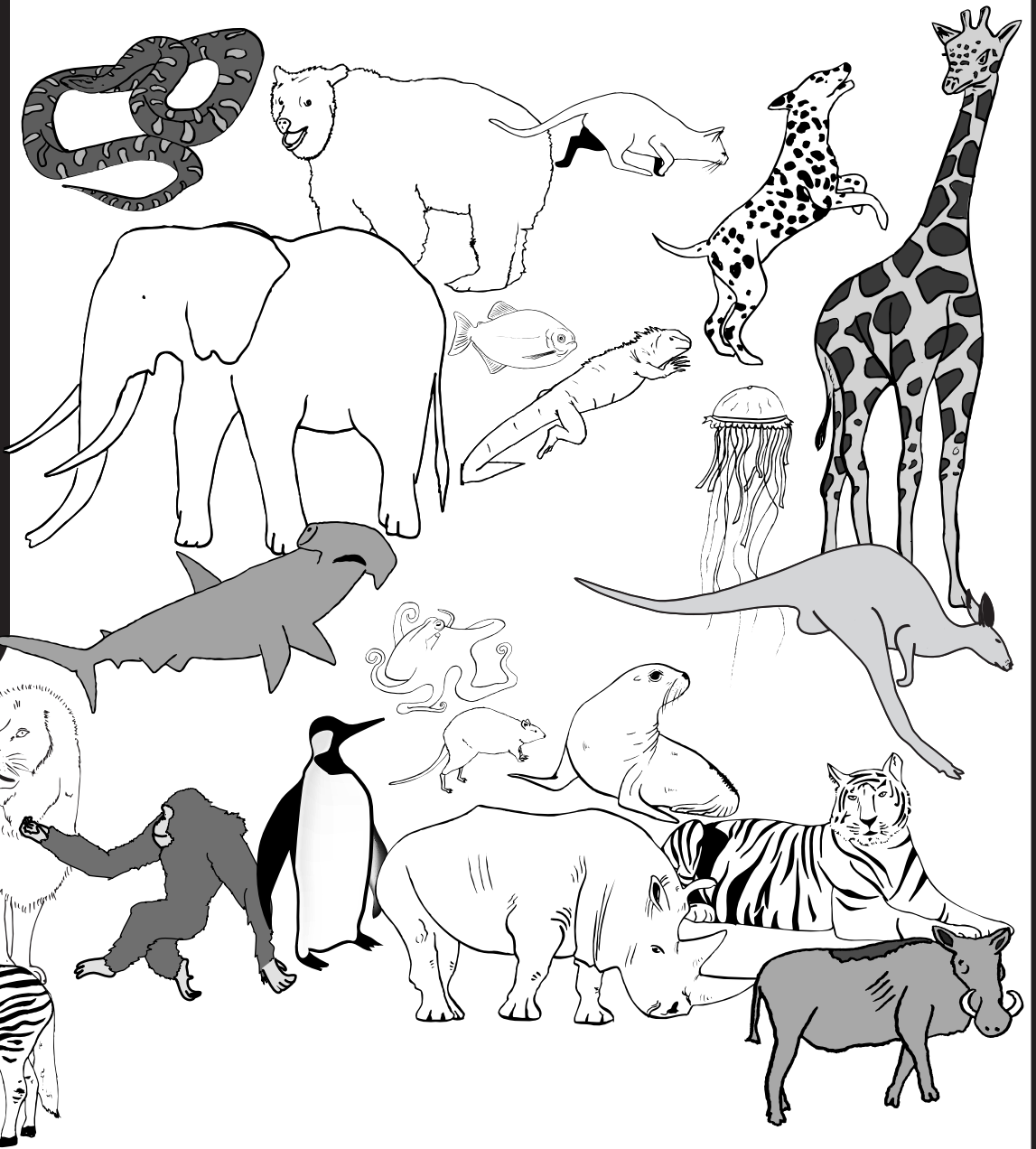
What to do...
