## Why choose Acorns?

The summer holiday is five weeks of fun, fun and more fun! It's time to unwind and chill out after working so hard during the school year. With our team of experienced Playworkers we have lots of fantastic activities, trips and much more planned for your children to enjoy. We plan activities based on what the children ask for, keeping in mind that the children will also choose the majority of their own play. Therefore, we provide as many resources available throughout the day for children to freely choose. We will use our vast outside space as much as possible weather permitting, and as much as we do try and stick to the plan, there may be occasions where we have to switch certain activities according to weather, this flexibility makes Acorns a more enjoyable experience for the children.

Sessions are available between 8:00am-6:00pm. Children attending the whole session are welcome to start anytime between 8:00am-10:00am (We may ask to you to arrive early on certain days if we have any specific trips planned) During this time, the children enjoy a relaxed morning having breakfast, free choice of play, watching the television or taking part in any other activities if they choose. We also find that the children like to use this time to carry out any "jobs" such as, watering the plants, helping with breakfast, organising the lunches and drinks bottles, the children can also use this time to add any diary entries along with their Key Worker into their Acorns Summer Diary.

## What do the parents need to know?

Please ensure that your child wears suitable clothing that is comfortable and weather appropriate. You may also wish to send your child in with some spare clothing that can be left at Acorns, some of our activities can get a bit wet and messy!

We ask that the children bring a sun hat and sun cream both labelled that can be left at Acorns. Children will need a water bottle and if they are attending the full day session and they will also require a packed lunch.

If your child is booked into Acorns but does not need to attend that particular day, please inform us by calling 01327 709727. Cancelled sessions will still be charged at the usual rate.

Acorns is open from 8:00am-6:00pm, we split our day into two sessions which are shown below. Sessions are invoiced on a monthly basis and must be paid for in advance.
