Please remember that it is your responsibility to call or report your child's absence to the school on the day of your child's absence by 8:45am at the latest. It is very important for safeguarding reasons that we know a child is safe at home with parents if they are not in school. It is taking a considerable amount of time for the office team to call and check on absences at the moment.

Illness:

We understand that attendance levels can be affected by illness, particularly colds and sickness bugs. We would encourage parents to send their children to school where possible. However, if your child has any sickness or diarrhoea, please keep them at home for 48 hours following their last episode of sickness. If your child has a high temperature, please keep them home until it has gone.

We look forward to seeing you there.












With summer fast approaching, we are in the process of organising Sports Day.

32.5 Hours per week

From September 1st 2023, every mainstream school in Britain must provide 32.5 hours of schooling each week.

This equates to school being open for 6.5 hours each day and includes all breaks that the children may have. This does not apply to Nursery.

Our school day will run from 08:45 - 15:15 each day.

This means we will be making some changes to our morning entry times.

FROM 5th JUNE 2023...

School gates will open at 08:40 and staff will be on the playgrounds to help children to go straight to their class lines.

School start time will be 08:45 and children should be lined up on the playground at this time. Staff will lead the children in at this time and gates will be locked almost immediately.

Reception children should aim to be at the classroom door for 08:45 please.

For the Summer Term only, children will **not** be marked late until after 08:50, but gates will close at 08:45.
