Thank you for your continued support. We know that this year will bring further challenges, but we're confident that together, we will overcome any challenges we face. Your ongoing support is very much appreciated.

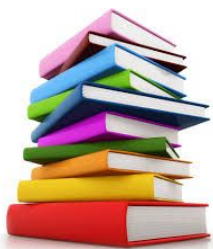

GET CAUGHT READING!

Your child will be reading a great deal in school this year. We have already completed our first reading assessment of the year, to help us to understand what your child needs next to develop their reading skills. We will allow children to bring home reading books, which will then be sanitised and placed in quarantine when they return to school. **Reading at home should be recorded on your child's Class Dojo portfolio please. Simply log the name of the book, page numbers and any comments.**



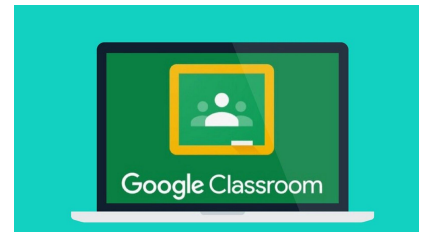
We are delighted that the overwhelming majority of children have returned to school this week. We will liaise with you individually if you believe your child is too ill to attend school and so, request that you call Miss Sutherland in the office. Obviously, there are also times when we may have to request that your child stays at home. This won't impact upon your child's attendance, but other absences will. It's vital that your child is in school - please call and discuss any possible absence with Amy Sutherland who will advise on our latest rules.

Remote Learning

If you have been advised that your child should self-isolate, they are expected to engage with learning from home. This is important - we had high levels of engagement in the Summer Term and this must continue. If we advise that your child should not be in school, they will be expected to engage with their lessons via technology. Obviously, if your child is unwell this is not the case.



We will be using Classdojo and Google Classroom to ensure that your child continues to access learning at the same rate as those children in school.



This is non-negotiable and we thank you for your support with this. If access to technology is an issue, we will discuss this with you at the start of your child's self-isolation period.
