Well done to all 327 pupils who reached our target of 96% attendance during the last week of term! Brilliant!

Late arrivals:

We have seen an increase in the amount of children arriving late to school (after 8:50am) *During the week before half term there was a total of* **1184** *minutes of late arrivals! This equates to over 19 hours of school missed. This must Improve!*

It is important that your child arrives at school on time. This helps them learn good timekeeping and reduces the chance of classroom disruption and possible feelings of embarrassment. Pupils who arrive after the registers have been closed, either in the morning or the afternoon, without an acceptable explanation or children who are regularly late will be marked as unauthorised absence.

32.5 HOURS PER WEEK

From September 1st 2023, every mainstream school in Britain must provide 32.5 hours of schooling each week.

This equates to school being open for 6.5 hours each day and includes all breaks that the children may have. This does not apply to Nursery.

Our school day will run from 08:45 -15:15 each day.

This means we will be making some changes to our morning entry times.



FROM 5th JUNE 2023...

School gates will open at 08:40 and staff will be on the playgrounds to help children to go straight to their class lines.

School start time will be 08:45 and children should be lined up on the playground at this time. Staff will lead the children in at this time and gates will be locked almost immediately.


Reception children should aim to be at the classroom door for 08:45 please.
