Dear Parents / Guardians

Please see the clubs timetable attached for term 5, starting on Wednesday 24th April until Thursday 23rd May 2019. Clubs will start back on **WEDNESDAY 24TH APRIL 2019**.

Clubs that are available for children to apply for are in the white boxes.

We must have slips back by Thursday 21st March 2019. Priority will be given to the children who are currently on the waiting lists.

If your child already attends a show related club (shown in blue) then they do not need to reapply. However, if your child no longer wishes to attend, you need to let the school office know as soon as possible.

The yellow boxes are clubs run by outside agencies. These agencies have their information on the letters attached to this one; please follow the instructions on the individual letters.

Please be aware that if your child does sign up for a club, then their participation and commitment will be expected each week. We try hard to optimise the number of clubs each child attends and so, commitment is vital. A register of attendance will be taken at the beginning of each session. If your child fails to attend the club, a member of staff will use your emergency contact number to contact you, to ensure that your child is safe. **You must inform the school office if your child will not be attending a club on a particular evening on 01327 705785.**

Please complete the permission slip on the attached sheet, one slip per club, which your child wishes to join. It is very important that you include any medical information and an emergency contact number. We can only allow your child to go with the person/s named on the form, so it is vitally important that this information is given. As the evenings are getting lighter, we can allow your child to walk home, but you must indicate this on the form.

We will inform your child that they have been given a place on their selected clubs, by returning a clubs timetable with the clubs highlighted.
