Our curriculum...

Maths:

In maths this term, we will be concentrating on developing our knowledge of Shape, space and measure. Within this topic we will be exploring 2D and 3D Shapes, length, weight, height, capacity, and distance.



Physical Development:

Fine motor: We will be supporting the children in correcting their letter formation and ensuring their pencil grip is correct.

Gross Motor: The children will be learning about controlling large movements including skipping, hopping and jumping.



Creative:

This term we will be experimenting with colour, design and texture to create pictures and models related to our traditional stories. We will be developing our imagination, through role-play and drama with Mrs Morgan.



Personal, Social and Emotional Development:

The children will be learning and understanding 'Stranger danger' and how to keep themselves safe. They will also be deepening their understanding of emotions and feelings and discussing when they have experienced them.
