


#### What do I need?

A Google Account (Email address and Password)


SafeSearch can be easily turned on for a single use, but for it to stay on you will need to lock SafeSearch. While on your browser go to google.co.uk and click the 'Settings' tab and click on 'Search Settings'.



Find the "SafeSearch Filters" section and check the 'Filter explicit results' box, then click on 'Lock SafeSearch'.



When prompted, sign in to your Google Account. If you haven't got an account click the "Create an Account" button.



Finally, to confirm, click the "Lock SafeSearch" button. You will need to do this on each browser that you use or if you have multiple Google Accounts.
