This term, Year 4 children will be finding about Europe, by exploring stories, legends and folk tales from the region.

The children will be discovering more about the countries and cities of this area by using a range of information sources including maps.

The children will also explore how different versions of the same tales exist in literature from across the continent.

The children will continue to develop their reading and writing skills; combining creativity and imagination with technical accuracy.

The children will also be taking part in a court-room style debate, where the big, bad wolf will be on trial!

Please encourage your child to read a range of 9 different books each month. Research
