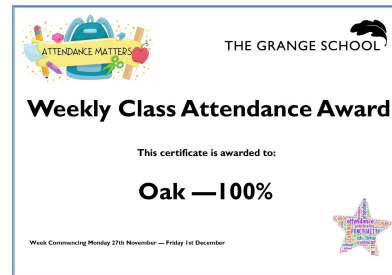

Every child is a different kind of flower, and all together, they make this world a beautiful garden.



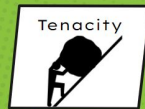

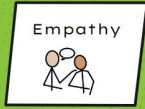

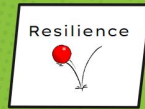
